How is our project helping to advance the quest for more participatory and deliberative democracy?





In theory

In our Conceptual Framework, we have identified several conceptual ambiguities, potential problems to be faced by the EUARENAS project, and inspiring debate topics in the fields of discourse studies, argumentative public policy, radical democracy, populism, leadership.

In addition, the latest research in progress on the topics of participation and deliberation are collated in an editorial called the EUARENAS Working Papers Series, published every December. Check out last year's Working Papers Series on "apoliticalness" and COVID-19.

In practice

To investigate emerging innovative and experimental governance practices and the main actors and strategies involved, we have exemplified 11 governance innovations in European cities.

The way people consume and make sense of media can be a source of foresight for the future of democracy. The Media Discourse Foresight Guide walks you step-by-step through how to use media discourses as source material for signals about our future and to explore the drivers of change in society.

Lack of involvement of decision makers, not collecting feedback from participants or exploiting inadequate facilities may ultimately taint the stakeholders' perception of the pursued activities. Governing our case study and piloting works are the Stakeholders' Inclusion Guidelines, which seeks to foster diversity, engagement, inclusion, and influence.









In policy

With the Preliminary Policy Brief to the European Commission, we mapped out the three dimensions of policy-making and explored how deliberative democracy at the local level can enhance relevant policy issues related to civic life.

To further knowledge exchange, we have launched a horizontal learning platform called the "EUARENAS Community of Practice". This community is composed of people from different professional backgrounds who share the same interest: networking, learning and sharing of data and practices on participatory and deliberative democracy in urban settings
